Fantasticals now has a 'Green Policy' that recognises its responsibility to act in an environmentally friendly way, commit to improvements in the way it operates and play its part in working towards a 'greener' planet.

Fantasticals green policy is built on the three simple principles; 1) Reduce, 2) Reuse and 3) Recycle. Fantasticals has reviewed the way in which it works and looked at introducing 'Green Initiatives' in all areas from product selection, to procedures right down to packaging and the consumables it purchases.

We have carefully selected suppliers who can comply with our environmental policies and are proud to stock products from companies such as Lanka Kade, Plan Toy and Orchard Toys. As well as ensuring most of their wooden toys are made from exhausted rubber plantations that are replanted every 10-15 years and re using packing materials, Lanka Kade are also a Fair Trade supplier. Plan Toy use replenishable rubberwood for their products which are preservative free and processed naturally. Plan Toy are highly committed to reducing waste and saving energy. All of our wooden products at Fantasticals have been selected because they are made from replenishable and sustainable sources such as rubberwood. Orchard Toys are a British toy manufacturer who use recycled card to make their board games and toys and are highly committed to their environmental policies.

The Fantasticals Team have a particular focus on recycling. All of our promotional material is printed using recycled paper and card, our packing material, boxes and tape are all recyclable and we re use packaging material used by our suppliers. This does mean that our packaging is not particularly "pretty" but we would rather re use than throw away!

In the Fantasticals offices, we operate a "power saving policy" and ensure all our staff are aware of this. That basically means all power supplies must be turned off at close of business including computers, monitors, lights, photocopiers and printers. We all try to adhere to this policy at home as well!
